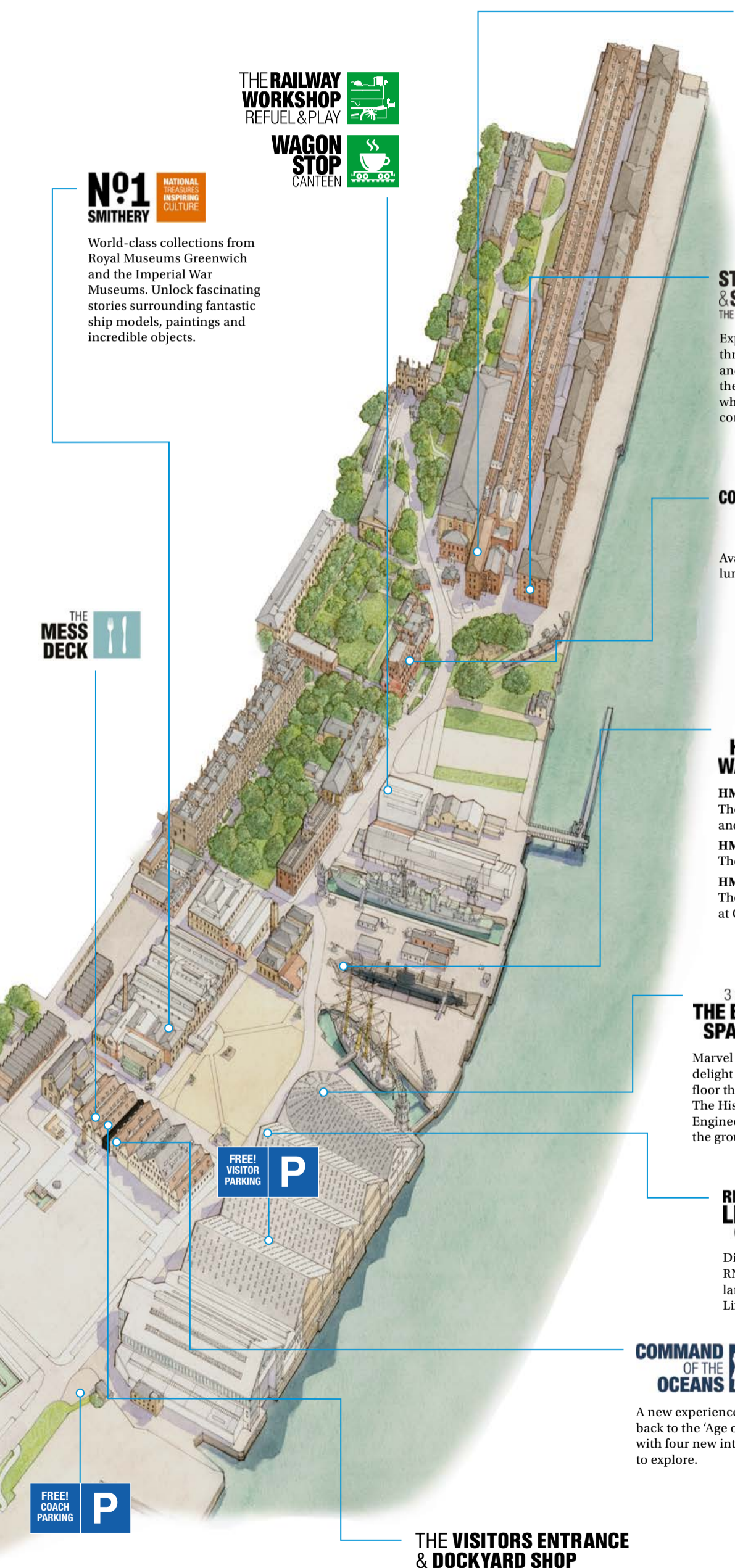

UNTOLD STORIES: A HISTORY OF AFRICAN AND CARRIBEAN PEOPLE IN KENT

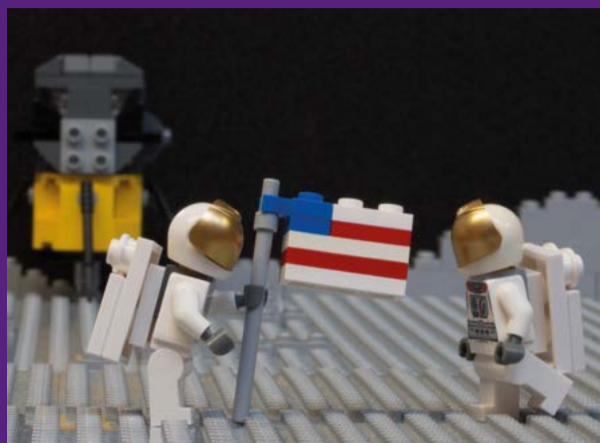
Oct to Dec 2018
